

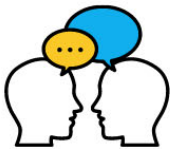

Explore **"respect"** through these books, available from the Spokane County Library*

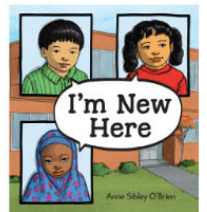
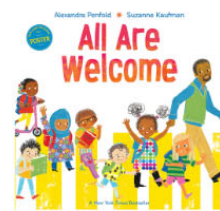


DO

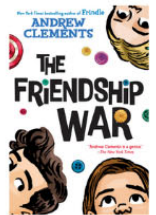

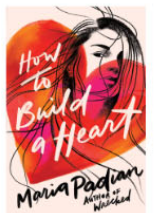
